

Mercer County Council on Aging Senior Levy – November 6, 2018

What is the Senior Levy?

The Senior Levy supports the services provided by the Mercer County Council on Aging (MCCoA). MCCoA supports Mercer County residents who are 60 or older to help them remain as active and independent in their homes for as long as possible.

This is a Renewal

A renewal means no new tax! The millage is .70.

A home appraised at \$100,000 pays \$24.50 a year or \$2.04 a month or just 7 cents a day!

What Services Does MCCoA Provide?

Chore, Homemaker, Outreach and Transportation

MCCoA also provides congregate meals, social activities such as bingo, cards, arts, crafts and line dancing, informational seminars, health and wellness activities, and volunteer opportunities.

By the Numbers

In 2017, MCCoA provided

11,100 rides for medical appointments, grocery shopping, banking and meal sites.

990 clients with chore services such as yard work, cleaning windows, shampooing carpets, building simple ramps, cleaning gutters, installing grab bars and other similar tasks.

2,740 hours of homemaker services.

1,060 client consultations and service assessments through outreach.

MCCoA is a not-for-profit organization. Funding for services is provided through Levy dollars, Passport, grants through the Mercer County Civic Foundation, client donations and the hard work of volunteers at MCCoA garage sales.
